The Troops To Teachers (TTT) Program was established to assist military personnel to transition from active duty or selected reserve units to a teaching career.

Eligible servicepersons can register with the Troops To Teachers program, administered by the U. S. Department of Defense (DANTES) and U. S. Department of Education, for state teacher certification referral and placement assistance. A national network of State Placement Offices has been established to help!

Certification training stipends (up to \$5,000) and placement bonuses of up to \$10,000 are targeted to military personnel who meet program criteria with a three-year commitment to teach in eligible public schools. A registration form can be downloaded from the TTT website below.

Undergraduate and graduate teacher certification preparation programs vary by institution. Contact each institution's Department of Education or Professional Studies directly for admissions and course requirements.

TTT referral, placement and financial assistance eligibility require a bachelor's degree, in most cases, in addition to military service requirements.

Participants eligible for training stipends (usually retired) must complete an application. Payments start after students are enrolled or admitted to an accredited program of their choice. A TTT placement bonus is available for those who qualify and complete a teacher certification program. A three-year teaching obligation in a qualified public school is required for both.
